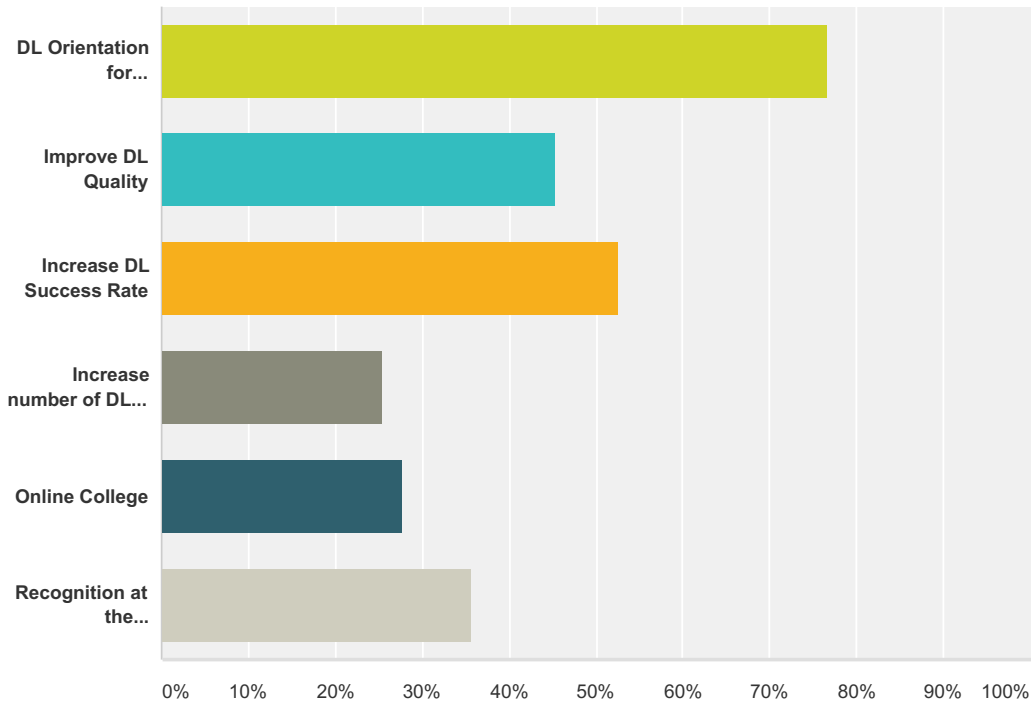


Q1 Distance Learning Choose the top three items that are most important to you.

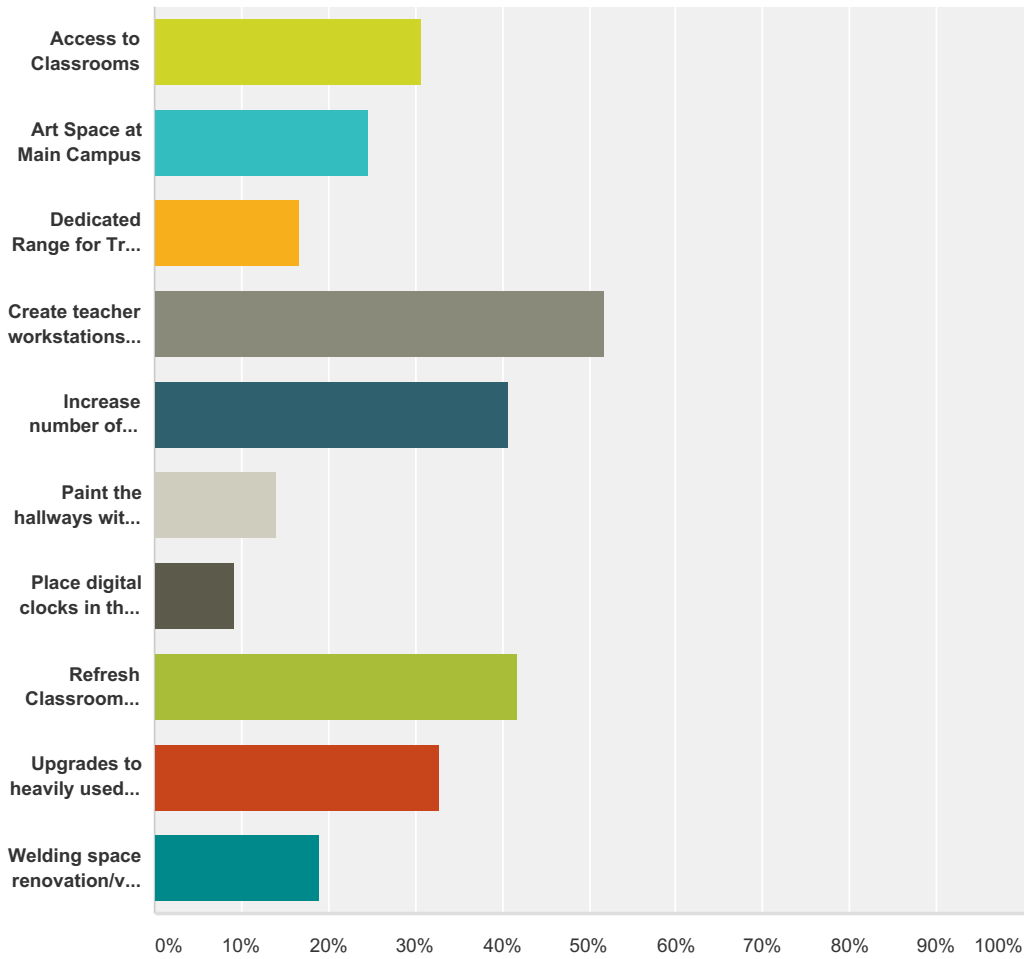

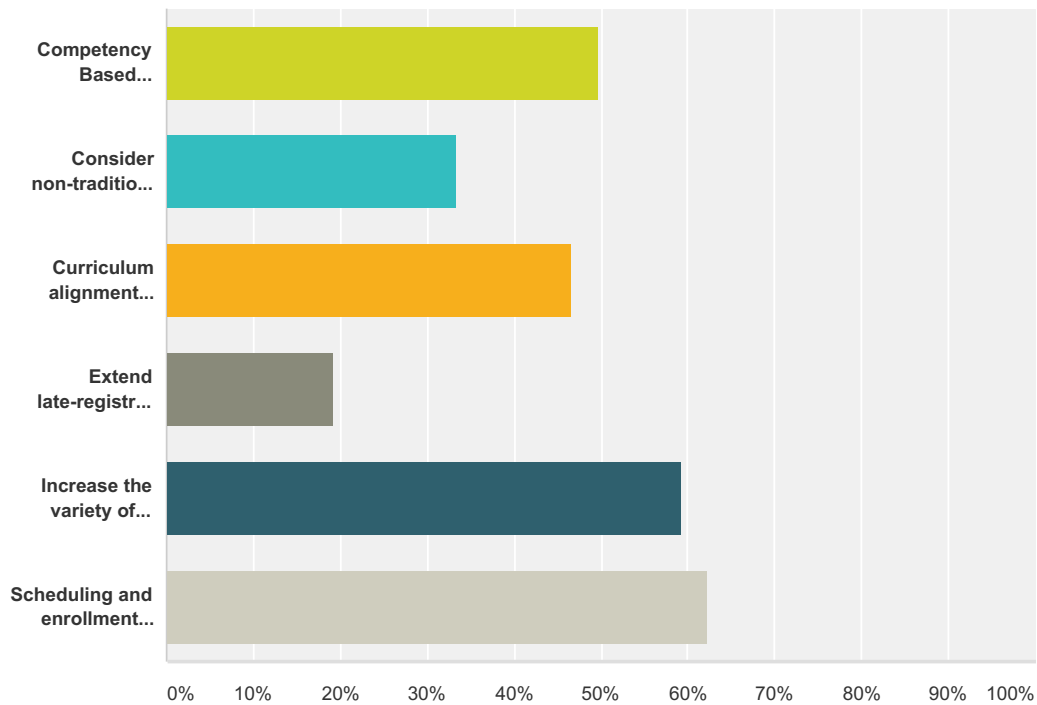

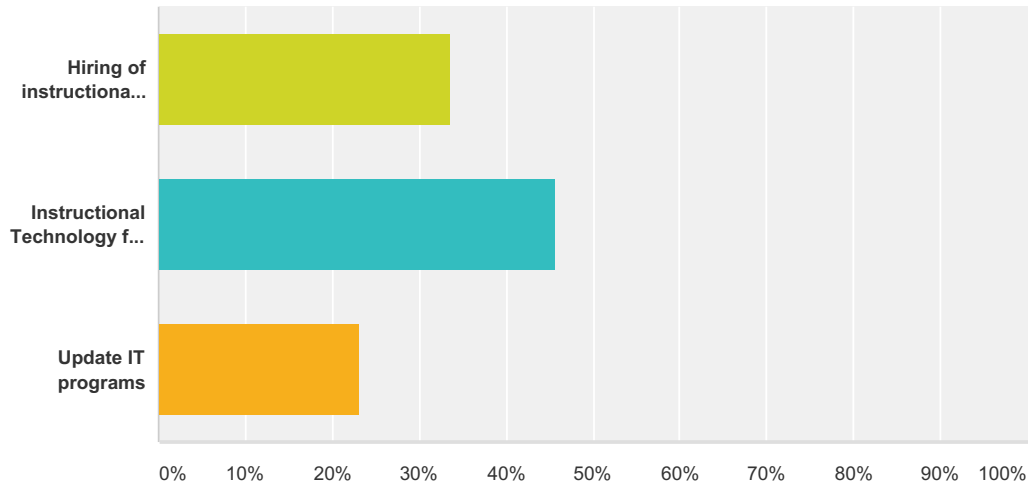

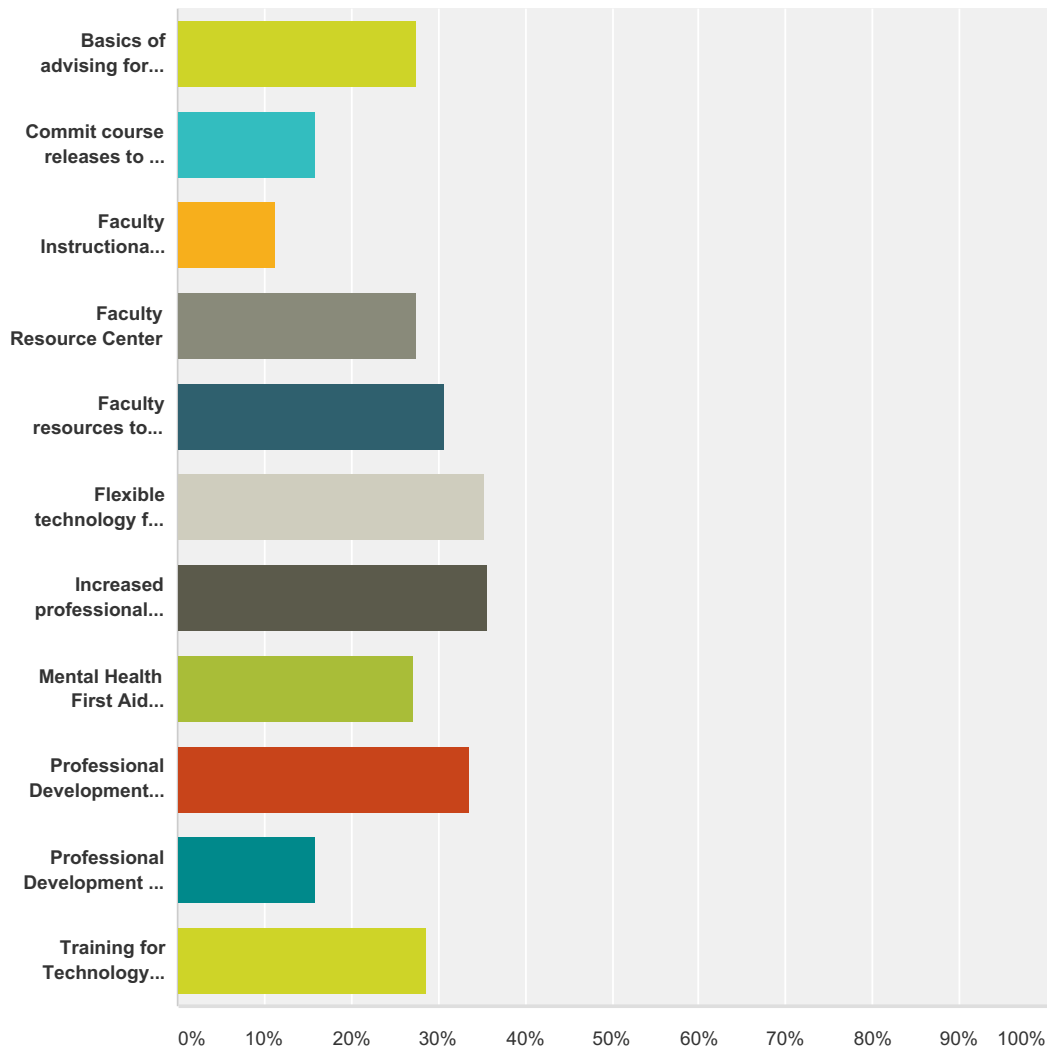

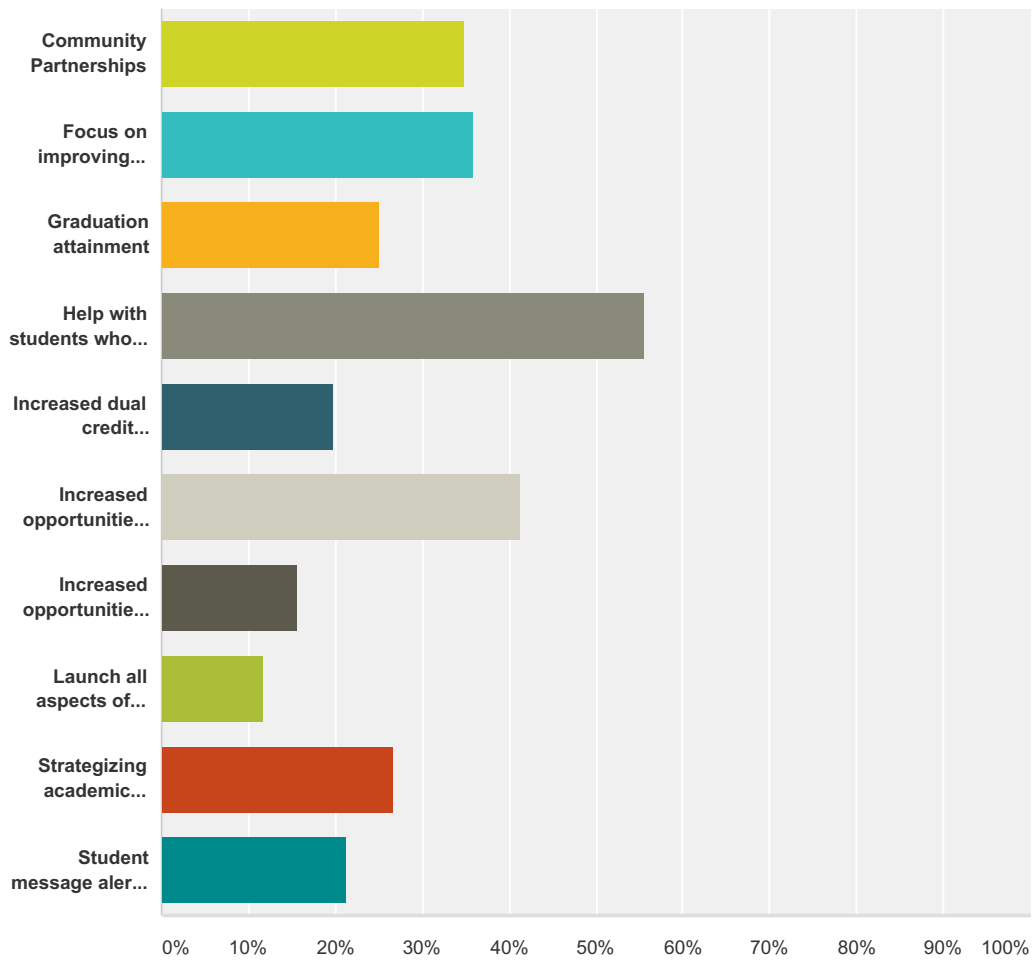

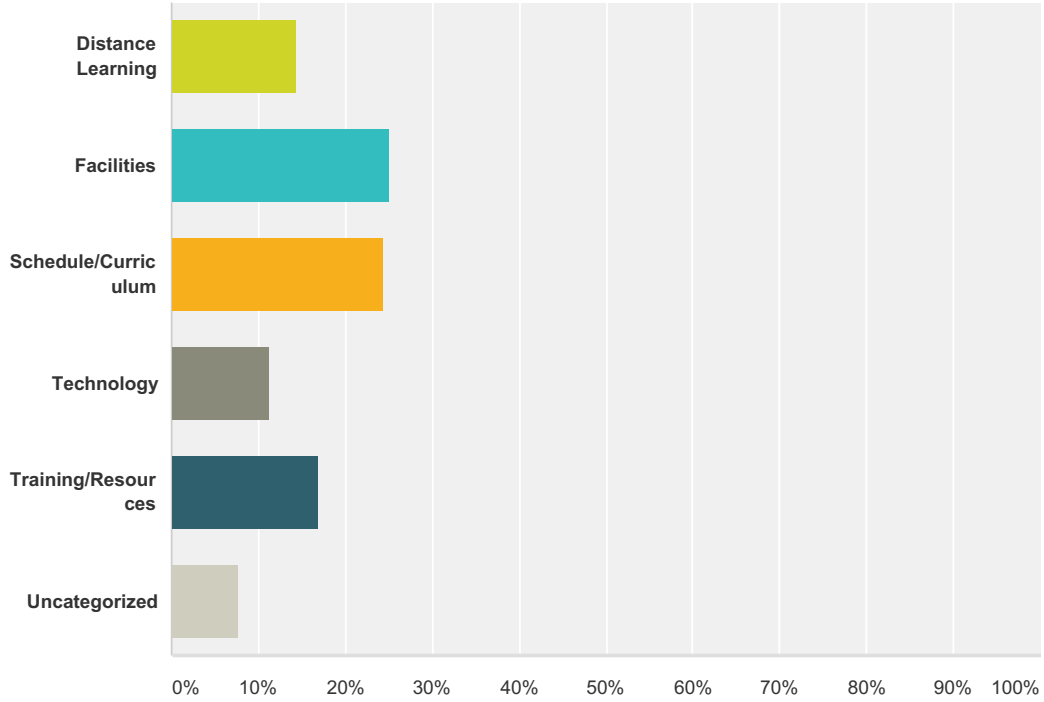
