- Students completing the Associate of Arts in Early Childhood Multicultural Education, Birth-3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Teacher Concentration at Central New Mexico Community College can apply those credits and courses directly toward the Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Multicultural Education in three concentrations at New Mexico Highlands University: (a) Age 3-Grade 3, (b) Birth-Age 4 Non-License Option, and (c) Birth-Age 4 License Option.
- Upon completion of the coursework prescribed within this transfer agreement and a cumulative 2.5 GPA, students will have earned an A.A. in Early Childhood Multicultural Education, Birth-3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Teacher Concentration, guaranteed admissions to NMHU, classified as a junior, complete appropriate prerequisites for Junior standing in the B.A. in Early Childhood Multicultural Education degree program, and have the NMHU institutional Physical Education and Language Competency core requirements waived.
