- Students completing the Associate of Applied Science in Business Administration at Central New Mexico Community College can apply those credits and courses directly toward the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration at Lewis University-Albuquerque.
- In following this agreement, students will earn an Associate of Applied Science in Business Administration, transfer seamlessly to Lewis University; whereby, students can complete their Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (CNM + Lewis University coursework). For more information, please contact Lewis University.
- This transfer agreement will be revised by CNM and Lewis University each academic year.
- Agreement shall not exceed eight (8) years.
