



## RESIDENCY QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES

You have been declared a *non-resident* of New Mexico for tuition purposes based on admissions information you provided to us. Continuing non-resident students can petition for a change in tuition classification by returning the residency petition and documentation supporting all residency requirements to Enrollment Services (original petition form required, no faxes). New students changing residency for the term you applied for only need to submit documentation correcting the condition(s) that made you non-resident. **All residency conditions must be met prior to the first day of the term.**

**Residency will not be changed after the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the term.** Any act from your prior admissions application (such as out-of-state overt acts) that caused your non-resident status must be proven to no longer exist.

**Non-citizens** of the United States who have applied for or obtained permanent resident status, or who serve on active duty in the armed forces of the United States, may be eligible for residency. \*

12 mont hs' consecutive residency. A student must physically reside in New Mexico for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the term.

financial independence

Students who are financially dependent upon parents or legal guardians who are nonresidents of New Mexico cannot be approved for residency.

intent

Student must sign a written declaration of intent to relinquish residency in any other state and establish it in New Mexico.

Two (2) overt acts: supporting intent; any out-of-state overt act will result in non-resident status.

### RESIDENCY GUIDELINES – IN-DISTRICT OR OUT-OF-DISTRICT

Students qualifying for New Mexico residency status for tuition purposes are classified as in- district or out-of-district based on their permanent physical address. PO Boxes are not eligible for in-district rates.
