## Construction Trades Scholarships Fall 2018 – Summer 2019

The Albuquerque Community Foundation and the CNM Foundation offer CNM students interested in a career in the Construction Trades a two term scholarship opportunity. This scholarship will be awarded to the top eligible applicant pursuing an associate's degree in a construction related program who meets all criteria. The scholarship is intended to assist an outstanding student reach their professional goals by helping cover costs associated with attending CNM.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Express the desire to begin a career in a construction related industry
- Enrolled in a CNM School of Applied Technology construction related Associate's program
  - Construction Management Technology AAS
  - Construction Technology AAS
  - Architectural/Engineering Drafting Technology AAS
  - Electrical Trades AAS – concentrations in Photovoltaic or Programmable Logic Controls
  - Heating Ventilating Air Conditioning Refrigeration AAS
  - Plumbing and Gas Fitting AAS
  - Machine Tool Technology AAS
- Currently hold a 3.0 cumulative GPA or better
- Intended for students with two or more terms remaining to complete degree
- Preference will be given to those students who plan to enter the construction field within 6 months of graduation

### Application Requirements:

- Print and complete this Construction Trades Scholarship Application
- Provide a one page personal essay addressing your interest in beginning a career in a construction related industry, your career goals, what areas of the construction field interest you, your expected graduation date, and why you have chosen the construction field as your career
- One letter of reference from an instructor

**To maintain eligibility:** The selected recipient must complete at least 6 credits fall with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better to receive the spring award.
