Application Requirements: Applicants must turn in a completed application form with the following documents attached:

- Personal statement explaining your unforeseen circumstance or emergency
 - ▲ Why you need the emergency funds and how money will be used
 - ▲ State exact amount requested, and who should be paid
 - ▲ Include your educational and/or career goals

- Two letters of recommendation Financial Aid will coordinate your two letters of support along with CNM Connect.
- Supporting documentation of the financial emergency (notice of layoff/ termination, receipts, police reports, medical statements, eviction notice, ect.) Please take a picture of your supporting documentation and submit with your application.
- Payment Contact Information; This may mean getting a completed and sign W9 from the prpvider. If that is NOT possible, please include a picture of a voided check to eliminate the need to come to CNM in person.

These documents will be used to determine the financial emergency and amount of award. Only copies of original supporting documentation should be submitted. Documentation will not be returned to the student. Only complete applications will be accepted.

Information regarding processing of application:

Applications will be reviewed on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Student's personal statement, academic progress, and supporting documentation will be used to determine the applicant's eligibility, level of emergency and amount of scholarship award. Awarded students will receive an award check payable to the service provider. Student will be contacted by phone after their application has been reviewed to inform them of approval or denial. Awarded students are contacted again when their check is ready to be picked up.

Rust Opportunity Assistance Fund will only be awarded one time within a twelve-month period.
