



APPEAL FOR RE-EVALUATION OF ARTS AND SCIENCES CREDITS FROM PRIOR COLLEGES

STEP 1 - Please read the following guidelines before submitting this appeal:

- An official transcript from the institution where the course was taken must be on file in the CNM Records Office for re-evaluation.
- Only credit for Arts and Science courses earned at regionally accredited postsecondary institutions will be re-evaluated.
- Courses with a D grade or better, earned at public NM institutions will be considered; courses from institutions outside NM and private institutions in NM must have a grade of C or better.
- Remedial courses and upper-division courses are not generally transferable.

STEP 2 – Your appeal for re-evaluation <u>must</u> include the following:

- ✓ A copy of the catalog cover and a course description from the catalog and/or syllabus from the course for the year in which the course was taken. (Contact prior institution for this information)
- ✓ Submit a separate appeal form and documentation for each course re-evaluation you are requesting.
